An exciting Student Leader Scheme was introduced in school from September 2012. Senior School Heads of Department and/or Staff who run extra-curricular activities as well as colleagues from our own Junior School have compiled job specifications for a variety of Student Leader positions. Girls may apply in writing to the relevant member of staff in the Spring Term. If successful, a student will be appointed, receive a 'Student Leader' (Sixth Form) or an 'Assistant Student Leader' (Year 11) badge and commence their duties from the following September.
